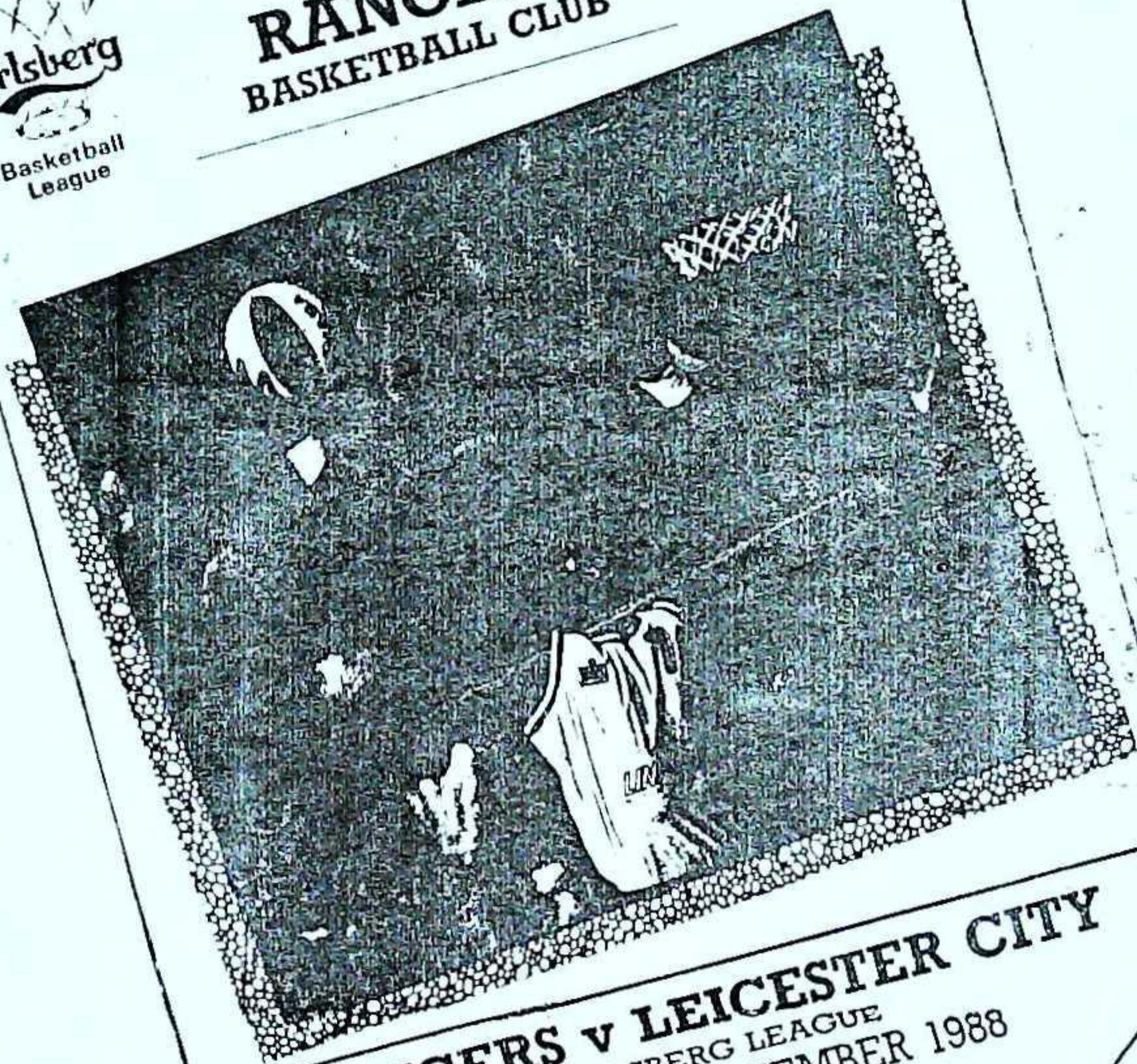

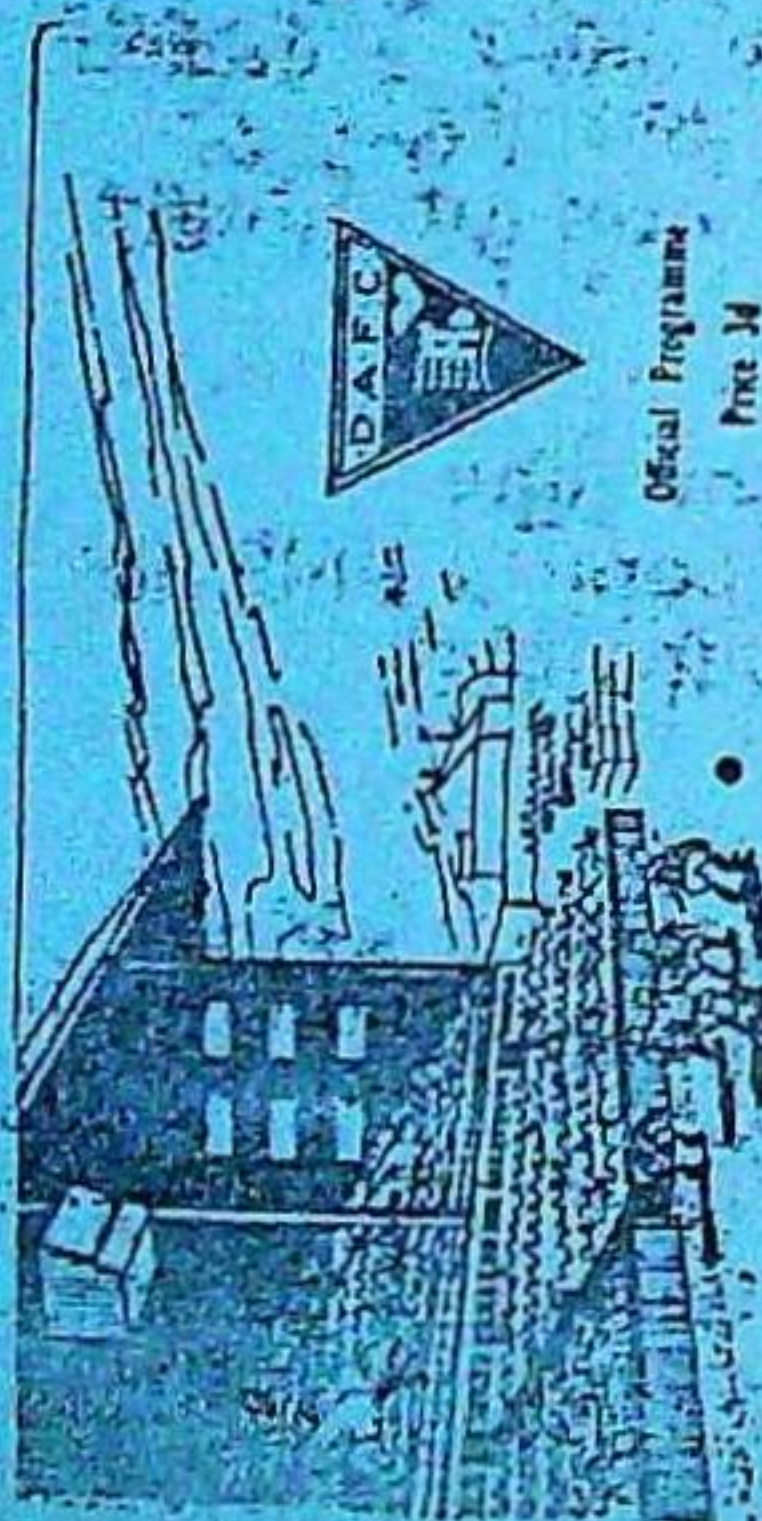

(Gillick had given Rangers a 24 minute lead, Ouchterlonie had equalised in the 50th minute) when Waddell was impended in the box and from the resultant penalty Young made it 2-1. Duncanson made the match save for Rangers with a third and final goal in the 81st minute.

In this edition of the bulletin the programme gem is slightly different from usual, in steady of one programme three will be covered. The quarter, semi and final from what was still know as the Scottish League Cup (it was to be renamed the Southern) of season 1945-46.

In the quarter finals Rangers who had previous over came Queen of the South, Motherwell and Morton in the sectional ties played Dundee at Hampden. The match was to turn on a very soft penalty 15 minutes into the second half. The scores were level at 1-1

After many near things Rangers finally equilised just before half time through Willie Thornton after good work bt Waddell and Williamson. The rest of the match was very poor after such a marvellous first half. Rangers winner came in the 13 minute of extra time Gillick scoring the winning goal.

The final was between Aberdeen and Rangers. Aberdeen got off to a great start with a goal by Baird after only 40 seconds and a second one by Williams in 16 minutes. Rangers now threw everthing into attack only to see a great Thorton shot beat Johnstone in the Aberdeen goal but hit the post. Aberdeen went in at half time 2 goals up.

It only took Rangers four minutes in the second half to score through Duncanson and when Thorton equilised after 75 minutes everybody thought they would go on and win the cup. But as the minutes tick away Aberdeen tie one more time for the winning goal. With 30 seconds left Taylor shot through a ruck of players to score and bring the cup to Aberdeen.

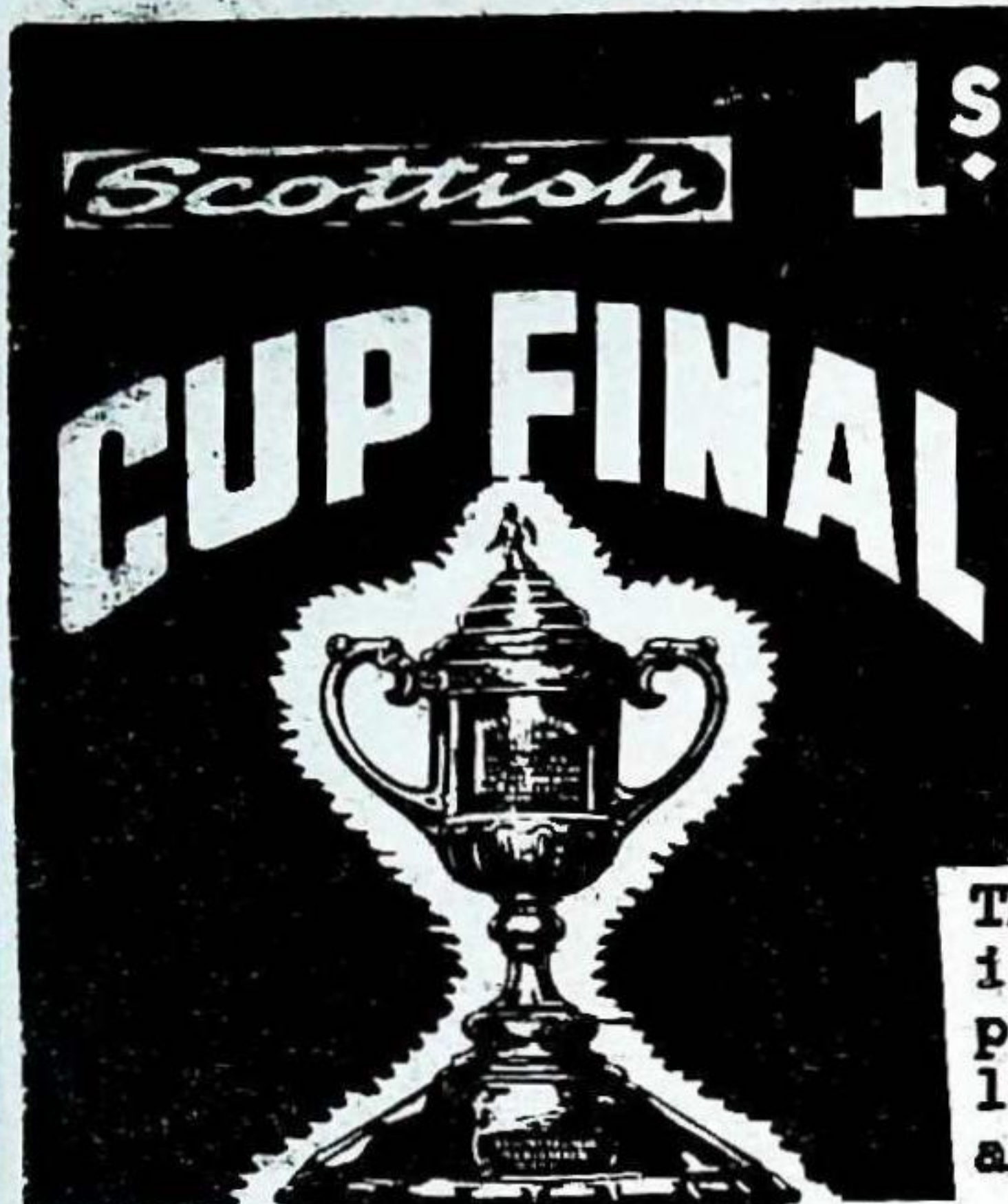

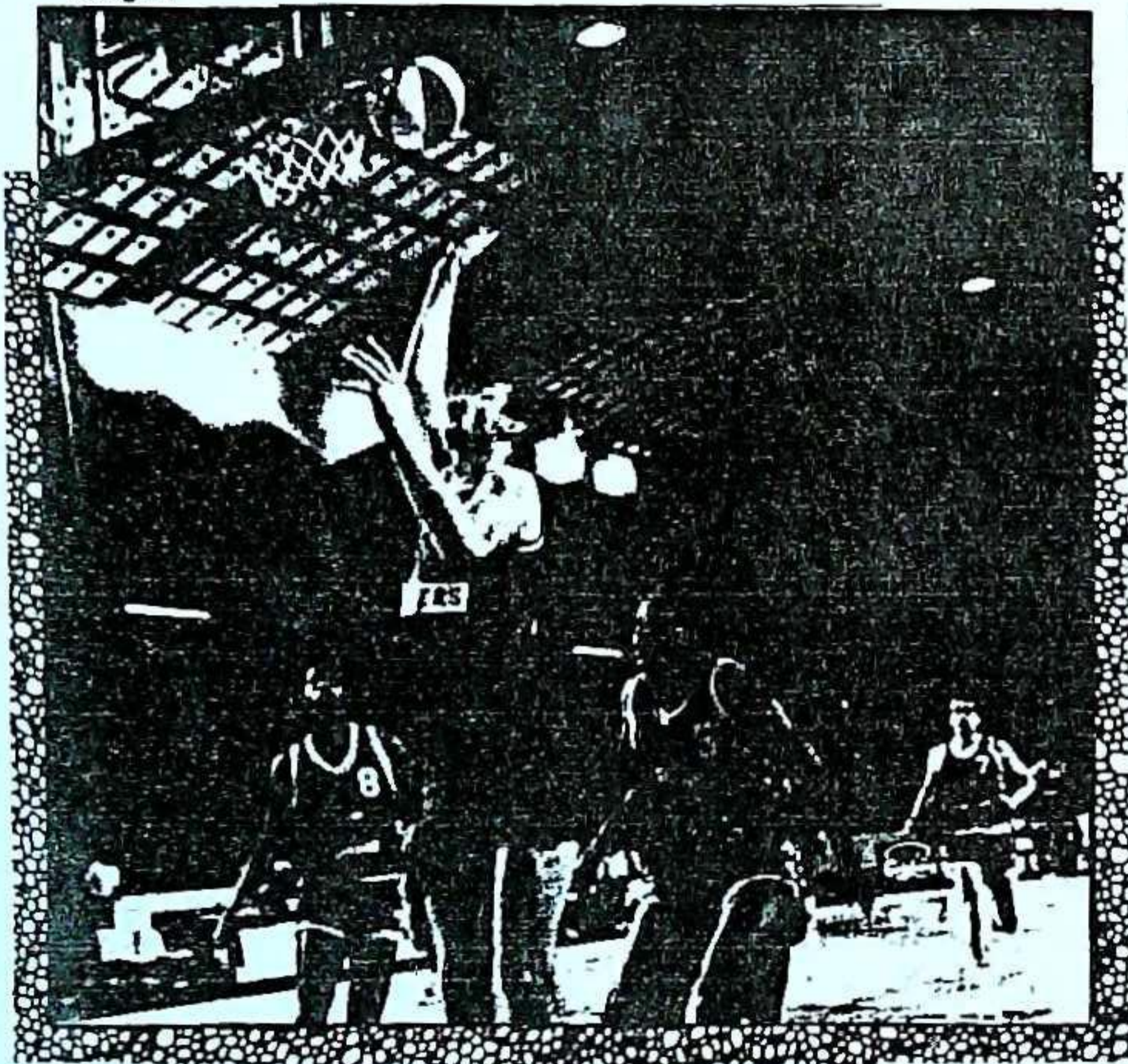

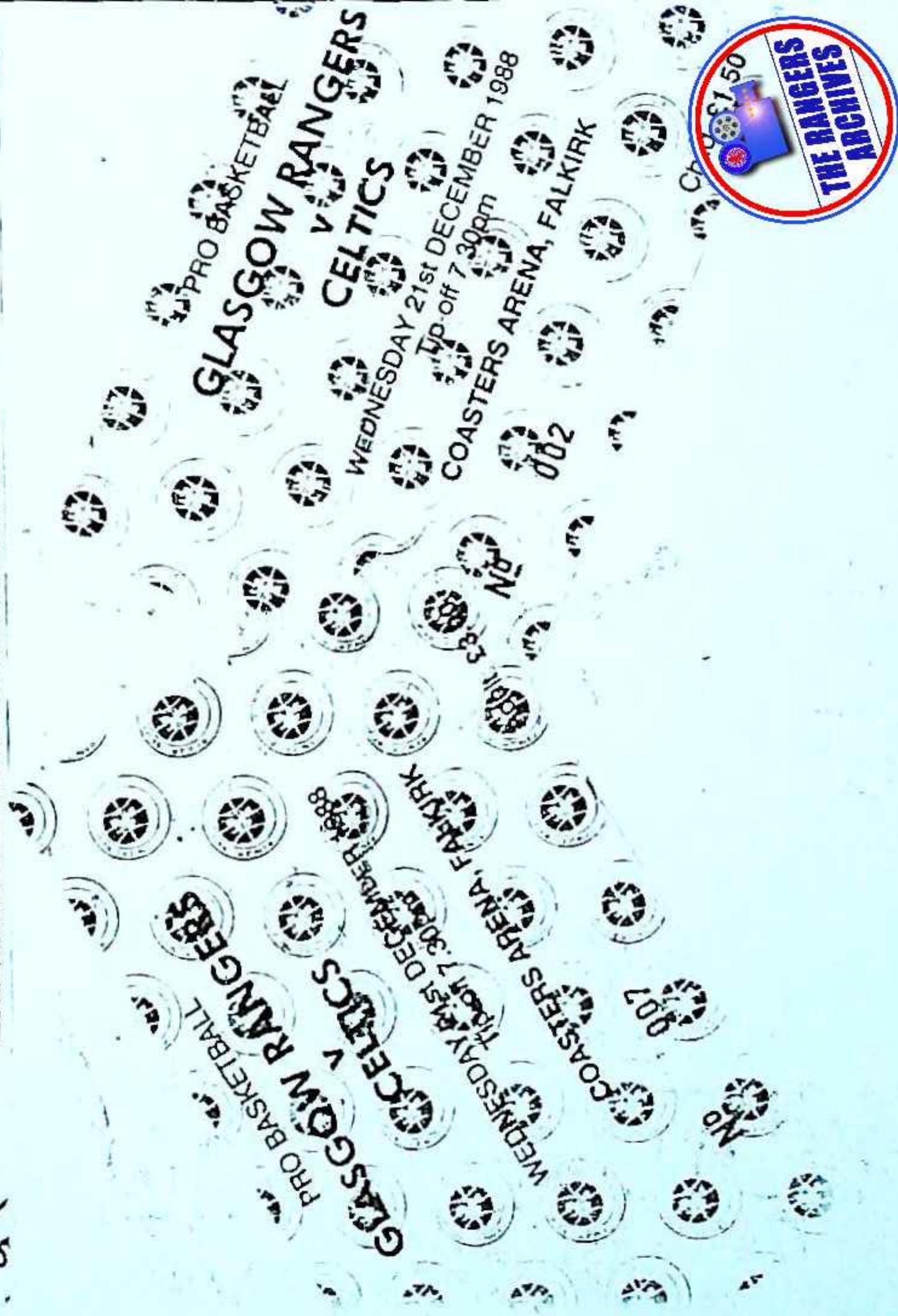
